Pastoral Ponderings

This is First Holy Communion weekend, and for the first time in my 13 years in the parish, I'm afraid the weather isn't going to cooperate and allow our children to gather in the undercroft and process from there into the church.

Instead, they will gather in the choir loft and then walk down the stairs for their Entrance Procession. But at least they'll be dry!

And the most important thing awaits them here, inside the church: their first opportunity to open wide the doors of their young souls and invite Our Lord to come in, to dwell within them in His Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity.

This is a great Mystery, and one which we should meditate upon frequently. He whom the Universe cannot contain humbles Himself to be contained within a small Host, and then - humbler yet - comes into our own bodies. For a few moments, we become living Tabernacles, true Dwelling-Places of the Most High God Who gave His life for us upon the Cross that we might live for ever.

Truly, He says to us: "The one who eats My Flesh and drinks My Blood will live forever, and I will raise him up on the Last Day."

The entire parish gains grace on the day of the First Holy Communion of our children. Our Lord is so pleased that we train our children to recognise Him, to love Him and to adore Him. He is ignored and even spurned by so many, but here He is loved and adored.

I encourage you to consider coming to Wednesday Holy Hour at least once in the next two or three months. Our Lord is present upon the altar from 6.15 to 7.15pm for silent adoration. At the close, we pray some prayers to St Joseph and then receive the Eucharistic Benediction of Our Lord. Please come!

This past Thursday I met with the pain specialist. He will administer cortisone injections in both the hip and the base of my spine on Friday 9th July, and then we'll see how I go from there.
Although my new electronic chair is a huge improvement on sleeping in my regular lounge chair, it's still sleeping in a chair, and I've been doing it for nearly four months now. It's like going to sleep in business class on an airplane - but every single night, and always arising in the same place in the morning, groggy and a bit stiff. Groundhog Day it is! But I'm alive and able to function, so just keep me in your prayers as I stumble along.
