

Pastoral Ponderings

Our Year 4 children, plus a number of interested adult parishioners, visited the Perth Synagogue to learn about Jewish life and worship, and how our own Catholic life and worship are deeply connected with the faith of the people of Israel.

'Alleluia' ('Praise God'), 'Hosanna' ('Lord, help us!') and 'Amen' ('This is true') are all Hebrew words that we have inherited from our Jewish fore-

The red lamp burning in the sanctuary, the use of incense, the standing for the Gospel and the kissing of the Gospel book are practices we have drawn from the Jewish faith.

The outline of our Liturgy of the Word reflects the weekly Sabbath service of the synagogue: readings from the Old Testament, the singing of a psalm, the homily, profession of faith and prayer of the faithful all follow the Jewish outline of worship.

And, of course, our use of unleavened bread for the Eucharist, and true wine (not grape juice) come to us from both the Passover and the Sabbath meal.

The synagogue leader who spoke to our group was very impressed by our children's behaviour and their understanding, demonstrated by their good questions and answers. It was a worthwhile visit!

This weekend we celebrate the beautiful Solemnity of Corpus Christi - the Body (and Blood) of Christ. As has been our custom, we extend our Mass a little bit with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament which is the fruit or product of Holy Communion at Mass - and spend some moments of Adoration: with prayer and song and silent reflection.

At the time of silent Adoration today, lift up to the Father, through His Son the Lord Jesus, all those you wish to draw into God's love. Let their names and faces pass before the eyes of your mind, so that they, too, may share in the Benediction which we will all receive on this special day.

I had my first COVID vaccination several weeks ago (AstraZeneca vaccine), and I'm still alive, with absolutely no side effects. I hope all of you can be vaccinated soon. Be not afraid!
