er spine osteoarthritis with disc bulge at two levels. The hips show mild osteoarthritis on both sides, and both knees have severe osteoarthritis with loss of joint space. My back has multiple problems that wouldn't be easily repaired by surgery. So I'm being referred to a pain specialist for possible nerve root injections; knee replacement is on hold until back pain sorted.

My bigger worry for me is our finances: two weekends in a row with low collections due to lockdowns, and our Presbytery account is low - we have two priests to support now. I continue to trust.
