Pastoral Ponderings

I am grateful to the many of you who expressed thanks and appreciation for last weekend's beautiful celebrations of Corpus Christi, with Adoration and Benediction at the conclusion of each Mass.

Your singing was heartfelt, and the silence during the short period of Adoration was profound. A few parents told me that they were praying that their little ones wouldn't disturb the silence, but everyone was focussed, and the 'silence was golden'.

At school this past Thursday we celebrated the feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, which was actually on Friday (and celebrated then in the parish). Since we only have Mass once per week for the students, I choose significant saints days and other feasts and move them to the Thursday, in order to expose our children to the example and teachings of our many saints.

So they learned about St Margaret Mary and the Promises of Our Lord to those who honour His Sacred Heart, and they learnt about the First Friday devotion, which so many of us have observed. If you haven't yet done so, you can begin any First Friday, and attend Mass and receive Holy Communion for nine consecutive First Fridays. Many spiritual graces are gained - Our Lord has promised this.

The entire parish gains grace - spiritual strength and energy - from coming to the weekend Mass with faithful regularity. But there are also those 'hidden' sources of God's grace:

- ◆ weekday Mass & Holy Communion
- ◆ Holy Hour & Adoration of the Bl Sacrament
- ◆ our fortnightly Rosary group
- ◆ private visits to the Blessed Sacrament
- ◆ devout reception of sacramental Reconciliation
- ◆ family and personal prayer at home

Thank you, all of you who are striving to live a deeper spirituality, who aren't satisfied with 'just doing the minimum' but who want to - as St Paul says - 'run the race so as to win the prize of eternal life.' Your spiritual efforts benefit us all.
