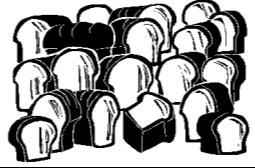

**Pastoral Ponderings**

*Thank you to so many of you who have expressed your concern about the two break-ins last weekend, and the attempted forced entry by two men into the Presbytery. Our Lady is protecting me!*

*But I scarcely got more than one or two hours of sleep from that Friday until this past Wednesday night, when - out of sheer exhaustion - I slept for 12 hours. And I spent half of that in my bed for the first time. It felt strange to be in bed after five months in my chair!*

*The Morley Police were very good all three of their attendances here! On Monday it looked like the SWAT team had arrived, with three squad cars and seven officers scouring the premises, taking photos and talking to me in very concerned terms.*

*They are afraid, as I am, that these intruders were 'casing the joint' in preparation for a major theft. What they do is locate everything they want to take and determine what equipment they will need. Then they often find unscrupulous shop owners who will quickly take the stolen goods off their hands.*

*What might be of special interest are our computer and monitors, projector, microphones, speakers (even the ones in the choir loft). They'd also like money, but we try to remove all money from church as quickly as possible, and bank it on Mondays.*

*In any case, let's pray for the people who broke into our church. These poor people are probably just desperate for drugs, cigarettes & booze money. I ask you to commend them to the care of Our Lady.*
