**The Wisdom of the Saints: Lust and Fornication**

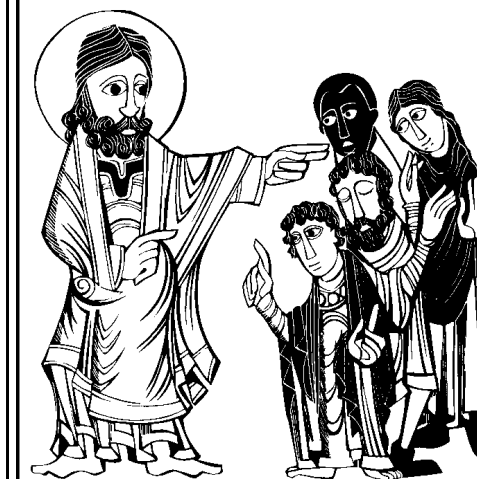

I try to keep up with the news every day: reading the West Australian (especially to see what people are thinking in the Letters to the Editor), plus The New York Times and The Times of London.

We Christians must be 'in the world, but not of the world' - that is, we should be aware of what is going on, and contribute to the common good and the building up of society; but we should not be dragged down by some of the bad morals around us.
