Pastoral Ponderings

We've received initial sketches of what our new parish campus will look like: the parish centre/presbytery, church and school annexe, plus a columbarium for ashes. I've shown these to some parishioners, who were overwhelmingly positive in their reactions. Now the architect is finessing the sketches after having consulted with me, and when he completes them, I'll show them to the parish.

These sketches will be included in a brochure that will be given out to you, and also circulated in the neighbourhood. When we present our plans to the City of Stirling, it will be important to demonstrate that we have no strong objections from neighbours. The sketches thus far have cost \$4,840.00 - so keep your pledges and donations coming in!

Speaking of money, we've certainly gotten our money's worth from our live-streaming system. Last week we live-streamed the weekend Mass, the feastday Mass for the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin on Wednesday (at which parishioners Martina & Lloyd D'Orsogna celebrated their 10th wedding anniversary), and Friday evening's Confirmation Mass.

Martina's family in Italy were able to view the renewal of marriage promises, many relatives and friends watched the Confirmation Mass; Lien Duong, our parishioner in Vietnam, and her family and friends there faithfully view our Masses, and my family and friends in the States appreciated being able to see last weekend's Mass where I spoke about my brother Kevin's death.

(I think at the Sunday 9.00am Mass, I forgot to tell the whole sad saga of Kevin's life prior to his death. If you wish, you can access the talk at the end of Mass by going to the parish website and fast-forwarding through the Mass video archived there.)

This is our cantor **Theodore Murphy-Jelley's** last weekend to sing for us before he leaves on Tuesday to pursue his second master's degree in music performance at the Royal Northern College of Music in Manchester UK. We are extremely grateful for the work Theo has done for us over the past six years, and we wish him every blessing as he moves forward in his career. Hopefully he will return to us for Christmas, but if not then, we'll surely see him sometime next year. Godspeed, Theodore!
