Pastoral Ponderings

Plans are steadily progressing on the transfer of Edith Cowan University from the Mount Lawley campus to an entirely new campus that will be built in the city centre, adjacent to Yagan Square and near the train station.

The present WAAPA buildings will be given to Mount Lawley Senior High School for use of its Fine Arts department.

Plans are to demolish remaining ECU buildings and construct housing for 10,000 residents.

This will impact both our parish and our school. If only 10% of these new residents are Catholics looking for a church, or are parents looking for a good school for their children, both our church and our school will need to grow.

This is one of the reasons why I and the Parish Finance Committee have set us on the path of new construction: parish centre & presbytery, church, and school annexe.

The proposed school annexe would be built on the site of our existing church - actually, on the area of the sanctuary (altar & sacristies), with a large lawn or oval covering the rest of the church area.

Our Year 4. 5 & 6 would move to this annexe, to permit the lower grades to become double-stream. fo: medjugorjewa1981@gmail.com or ring We have huge waiting lists for the lower grades, but at the end of Year 3, a good number of our boys transfer to Trinity College, and we are left with small classes in Year 4, 5 & 6 that still require full-

> By relocating the upper grades to the annexe here at church, we can take in more students in the lower grades, and then combine the students remaining

> The upper-school students would still go to the main campus on Learoyd St for assemblies, library work, dance and other events that go on in the

Since it is Year 4-5-6 that attends the weekly Mass, they would be right next-door to the church and not need to walk down from the main campus.

Hopefully, the Catholic Education Office will help us financially with this plan of expansion, which will enable us to take in more students overall.

Our architect is finishing the street perspectives of the new parish centre, church & school annexe - as soon as they're done, I'll present them to the parish.

This weekend, we welcome our new parish cantor, James Pinneri, a 23-yr-old baritone from WAAPA. James has sung here before in our choir for special events like Christmas and Holy Week. We look forward to his help in adding beauty to our Masses.
