

Pastoral Ponderings

I hope you have read the quotes above from our dear St Therese, who faithfully keeps watch over the door of our church.

When she died in 1897, her autobiography The Story of a Soul was a sensation, and it became an international best-seller. If you haven't yet read it please make it a point to do so this month - you can find it at Gatto's or online. It is a spiritual classic.

Therese Martin was a spoiled little girl who sorely desired to become a saint. She did, but she had to overcome obstacles created by others, and created by her own personality. Her 'Little Way' of holiness shows that anyone can become a saint - if you want.

We will have a Triduum (three days) of prayer to St Therese before her feast day this Friday. Try to join us, either in church at Mass or on your own. Leaflets are available in church and also online.

Let's all pray for Theodore, who is in Manchester, but is unable to begin his studies for his master's degree in music performance.

He sent his passport to the UK in July to get a two -year student visa. His classmates received theirs back in two weeks, but his only arrived at his home here on Thursday! He had to get an emergency passport the week before he left Perth, but entered stall. Details / tickets (\$40 single, \$60 | the UK on a three-month visitor's visa. If he doesn't get his old passport (with the UK visa) this week, he will have to leave the UK and then re-enter and reapply for a visa.

> Theodore is very upset and worried - can we make his cause one of our prayer intentions this week? And let's ask the Angels (who have two feast days this week) to speedily send the passport on its way (Theo's mother posted it on Thursday). Thank you.

> Another one of my concerns is Leonie's worries over our parish finances. I keep telling her to (in Padre Pio's words) pray, hope and don't worry!

But we once again have a stack of invoices to a total of over \$10,000.00 - but our weekly income varies pretty wildly: from \$1,200 to \$2,100, depending on the weekend.

You folks have a regular income, whether from a salary or pension or whatever. You know what you have each month. But the parish doesn't have a regular income. Some of you do give regularly by direct debit or planned giving. But a lot of you give only when you attend - and if you don't attend each weekend, the parish income fluctuates along with your Mass attendance habits.

But the bills don't fluctuate - they keep coming with great regularity! So please keep this in mind and have mercy on those who worry about parish finances. (I'm asking St Therese for help this week!)
