Daíly Prayers

St Therese, you patiently endured the disappointments that God allowed in your life, and you preserved peace in your soul because you sought only God's will. If the favours that I am asking are pleasing to Him, then obtain them for me; but if not, may God's will be perfectly fulfilled in me. Here are the favours that I now request : (silently state your intention now)

Day 3: Thursday 30 September

Little Flower of Jesus, you spent your young life denying yourself in all things, so as to follow Jesus more perfectly. Help me to patiently bear the trials of my daily life. Teach me to use the difficulties that come my way to know myself better and love God more. Obtain for me from Jesus the favours which I now so earnestly seek: (silently state your intention now)



Concluding Prayer (pray each day of the Triduum)

Almighty and eternal God, You glorified Your faithful daughter Therese as a model of holiness, and through her You have taught us to follow the 'little way' of the Gospel.

Give us the childlike faith that she possessed. Help us, like her, to see the Holy Face of Your Son Jesus in the people and daily encounters of our lives, and to approach You with love and complete confidence. Through her powerful prayers, may we and all those dear to us be protected in every way in this life, and come to the joys of the world to come, through Christ our Lord. Amen.
