



As we adore together the Most Blessed Sacrament at the conclusion of Masses this Corpus Christi weekend, let's offer Him:

- our **praise** for the wonders of His creation
- our **thanks** for His personal gifts to us
- our **petition** for the things we need
- our contrition for our sins

Use the time of Adoration well. If nothing else, you might read the Wisdom of the Saints in the box above: there are some beautiful thoughts about the Holy Eucharist.

We are all blest that the Lord has called us to this parish. At least half of the members live outside the parish boundaries; some drive a good distance - from City Beach, from Ellenbrook, from South Perth, from Nedlands - to worship God in this parish.

I might add that the people who come from afar don't just attend Mass here: all of them are active in the parish in one way or another. They help to build up a true community of faith.

It's important that each one of us appreciates what we have here at St Paul's. The Second Vatican Council (1962-1966) reminds us that the Liturgy is the source and the summit of our Faith.

From the Mass we draw all the graces God gives us to live our lives well, and to weather any storms we encounter. In the Eucharist, Jesus says to as, as He said the Apostles when He calmed the storm: "Do not be afraid: It is I."

Yes it is truly Jesus Whom we adore and receive in the Blessed Sacrament. And, being the summit of our Faith, Holy Mass is the best and most perfect prayer we can offer to God the Father. Even if we are distracted, tired or bored, just making the effort to be here at Mass is an act of worship. After all, sometimes we're distracted, tired or bored when caring for our children - but we still love them!
