

Pastoral Ponderings

I had to laugh when I read the bit about Death by St Ignatius of Loyola (just above here).

The saying goes that 'there are only two things in life that are certain: Death and taxes. Yet we read from time to time about people who have managed to cheat the Taxation Office.

Yet no one can avoid Death. And I capitalise the word for a purpose: to remind us of the solemnity of the event in which we will all share. * * * *

I don't worry about my own Death too much, but I am curious about the manner and the timing of my Death. I want to be at least somewhat prepared.

On my mother's side, everyone seems to either get cancer or heart disease, and they die relatively young: from late 30s to early 70s.

But on my father's side, most people seem to live into their 90s to early 100s. Except my dad, who drank and smoked a lot, and died at 78 of diabetes. Everyone in the family says, "He was ONLY 78!" And we all laugh. * *

As for me, I visit my GP regularly, get all the blood tests, X-rays, scans and what-not done. (What-not includes a colonoscopy - which I actually enjoy, because when I awake in the recovery room, I love the little triangular sandwiches they serve me in bed! The nurses laugh when they see me coming, and they say, "Your sandwiches will be waiting, Father."
