The Wisdom of the Saints: Christ


If you are wondering about what path you should take in life, take Christ - because He Himself is the Way. - St Thomas Aguinas

Pastoral Ponderings

We are grateful to all those parishioners of all ages who assist at our Masses as readers, acolytes, altar servers and IT operators.

Fr Mariusz has trained a number of men to be new acolytes; some of them have been functioning already as senior servers. We are waiting on the Archdiocese to officially install these men in the Acolythate.

Fr Mariusz has also trained a new crop of altar servers. It's always good to see how devout and careful our young people are in fulfilling their duties at the altar. Visitors often remark on how welltrained and reverent our servers are. Thanks, kids!

I'm grateful that several adults have stepped up and offered to be readers at Mass. And they are mostly new parishioners, so it's great to see that they want to be involved in our community. But we can always use more readers - if you'd like to serve in this ministry, please see me or Fr Mariusz, or contact Genevieve Saldanha (see the Ministries list at the bottom of the facing page).

The pandemic created a need for a new ministry at St Paul's: **IT operator**. This involves moving the PowerPoint along at all three weekend Masses (which doesn't take a lot of talent, but it does require that a person pay attention during Mass!).

However, since we are still live-streaming the 4.30pm Mass on Saturdays (and people still watch this, not only here but throughout the State), the IT operators for that Mass must also operate the two cameras. It isn't hard, once you get the gist of it, but it does require attention to the task.

Some of our young people stepped up at the start of the pandemic and have been doing a wonderful job handling the IT for us. But they're getting older and they have various school activities and sport, plus their studies, that make it harder for them to commit to this ministry week after week. They are willing to stay on the roster - but we need more IT operators to share in this burden - I mean, ministry!

If you can help and want to learn, Grace Torre is happy to have you sit with her at Saturday 4.30pn Oh, my poor friend, what answer will you Mass over the next two weekends to 'show you the ropes'. But then she's off on a school excursion for a few weeks. So if you are interested, jump in now and learn how to share our Mass with many people across WA - and, actually, across the globe!

You may have noticed that our Ongoing Expenses

have dropped to \$1,370.50 this weekend - far below the usual \$4,000 to \$6,000. This is thanks to several generous donations we received last week. I was so grateful to receive these extra funds, because it has allowed us a bit of breathing space - if only for a weekend or two. As I wrote here last weekend, 'God will provide' - and He did, thanks to you! God bless.
