As you know, LifeLink funds 14 different agencies of the Church, reaching out to people with various disabilities, as well as migrants and Aboriginals. am pleased that you generously support the work of the Archdiocese in these areas.

This is a busy time of year for musicians, with a wide variety of programs going on around the Perth area.
