

## The Wisdom of the Saints: The Scriptures

What moved and stimulated me most was reading the Holy Bible, to which I have always been very strongly attracted. There were passages that impressed me so deeply that I seemed to hear a Voice telling me the message of what I was reading. - St Anthony Mary Claret

The collection of Psalms in the Scripture, composed under divine inspiration, has - from the very beginnings of the Church - shown a wonderful power of fostering devotion among Christians. - Pope St Pius X

Bk 2, Ch 4/5 Sometimes we are moved by our passions and think that it is religious zeal. We condemn small things in others and ignore serious things in ourselves. We are quick enough to feel it when others hurt us-and we even harbour these feelings – but we do not notice how much we hurt others. A person who honestly examines their own behaviour would never judge other people harshly.

An inwardly focused person puts the care of their own soul before all other cares, and a person who attends to themselves does not gossip about others. You will never be inward and devout unless you stop talking about other people and start watching over yourself.

If you are utterly focused on the state of your own soul and on God, you will not pay much attention to what other people are doing.
