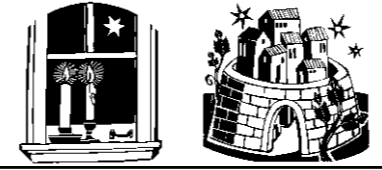

**Bk 2, Ch 4/5** Sometimes we are moved by  
our passions and think that it is religious  
zeal. We condemn small things in others  
and ignore serious things in ourselves. We  
are quick enough to feel it when others  
hurt us—and we even harbour these  
feelings—but we do not notice how much  
we hurt others. A person who honestly  
examines their own behaviour would  
never judge other people harshly.  
An inwardly focused person puts the  
care of their own soul before all other  
cares, and a person who attends to them-  
selves does not gossip about others. You  
will never be inward and devout unless  
you stop talking about other people and  
start watching over yourself.

If you are utterly focused on the state of  
your own soul and on God, you will not  
pay much attention to what other people  
are doing.
